Dear Fellow Members,

On behalf of your board, I will first thank all of you, especially those who have been able to volunteer both time and talent, during these very difficult times. Secondly, and equally important, those of you who have continued to support the Club, even while not being able to enjoy it, due to the difficulties resulting from the Pandemic.

The Club has managed to provide some degree of enjoyment, while maintaining compliance with the current restrictions presented by the Pandemic during these months as a result of the beautiful outdoor facilities it provides. Also during this time, although unable to use the indoor facilities, many volunteers tirelessly carried on the task of maintaining and revitalizing the Club. The Stammtisch continues to be under construction but much progress has been made. The outside bar has been renovated including a facelift and updating of the draft delivery system. The following is from the October 13th e-mail blast and contains important necessary information about our indoor dining policy .

*Due to recent modifications, in the Covid-19 Restrictions and the fact that we are in compliance with the Self-Certification Process requirements, the indoor facility may be opened up to 50% capacity. Please note, the following procedures will still be in place, in order for us to ensure **Social Distancing** and remain in operation:*

*It is suggested that all members **make reservation in advance**. Reservations may either be by phone or through the website, this way we may ensure we are maintaining the 50% requirement. Once at capacity we are not permitted to allow others to enter until others depart.*

We will be providing additional seating in the bar area as we are currently not permitted to seat anyone at the bar. Reservations in this area are not required but are limited to 20 occupants.

Food must be ordered during the consumption of alcohol. Last call will be at 9:45pm as the bar closes at 10:00pm. The Club will close at 11:00pm.

*You will be **required to wear a face mask** when entering the Club, as you are seated and whenever you leave your table. **Entering the Club will be through the rear entrance**, either by way of the ramp nearest the rear entrance to the kitchen or by way of the stairs nearest the secondary parking lot.*

*You will be asked to **provide your name and a phone number** for contact purpose only, should there be the need.*

*You will be asked to make **use of hand-sanitizer when entering and leaving**. You will be **Escorted** to your table.*

Servers and staff will be gloved and masked during your dining experience. They will also be clearing and sanitizing tables and chairs after your visit.

We ask that all members be considerate of one another by observing Social Distancing, Masking as is required, and allowing one another to enjoy the Club by keeping to our Seating Arrangement.
